Installing Adobe Digital Editions (ADE)

- Once you have clicked **Borrow** in previous step, click the **Download it now**
- On Adobe page, select either **Macintosh** or **Windows** and follow prompts to install
- Once installed, you will need to authorise ADE
 - ◇ At top of page, click **Help**, the **Authorise**
 - ◇ Click **Create an Adobe ID** link
 - ◇ Create ID using email address, name, DOB and password
 - ◇ When complete, return to the **Authorise your computer** window and enter details you just created (Adobe ID is email address, password is one you have just created)



Using a smart phone or tablet

- Go to your favoured App store and download the **libby, by overdrive** app
- Respond **Yes** to Do you have a Library card?
- Select I'll search for a Library, then search for **South Australia Public Library Services**
- Select **Enter Library Account Details**, enter your Library card number and the PIN that is linked to the card, then select **Next**
- Once a title is selected click borrow or place hold

Using a desktop computer

- Go to **www.ahc.sa.gov.au**, choose **Libraries**, click on **eBooks** or **eAudio Books**, then on the **Overdrive** icon
- Click **sign in**, enter your Library card number and the PIN that is linked to the card
- Click on a title, then **Borrow**
