## Library Membership

As a member of the Mount Barker Community Library you are a member of the 'One Card' network and can borrow and return within any participating 'One Card' Library.

Your membership includes access to computer services. Please phone or come into the library to make a booking.

A Wireless service is also available through the public library network. Please register at the customer service desk in the library.

## Borrowing

Borrow up to 100 items on your card for 28 days. Borrowing limits to some item formats apply including 20 DVDs, 20 CDs and 20 CDRoms. These items may be borrowed for 14 days. Toys may be borrowed for an annual fee.

## e-collections

You can borrow e-books, e-audiobooks and digital magazines with your library card. Please ask staff for details.

## Library Terms and Conditions

I agree;

To be responsible for all items borrowed by me or by members for whom I am the registered parent or guardian

That anything lost, damaged or not returned while on loan to me or to members for whom I am the registered parent or guardian, must be paid for.

To pay any fines incurred by me or by members for whom I am the registered parent or guardian.

To notify the Library if I change my name and/or address.

To notify the Library if my membership card is lost or stolen. I agree that I am responsible for anything borrowed prior to notification.

To be considerate of other people when using the library and behave in a way that will not disrupt their use of the library.

To abide by all library policies and heed any instructions given by library staff.

**By signing your library card, you are agreeing to these terms and conditions.**

At the time of becoming a member, you will be issued with a borrower's card for you to present when borrowing items.

In the event that you lose your card, please inform the library and another card will be issued to you for a fee of \$1.10.

## Fees

Costs will be incurred by you should any library stock become lost or damaged whilst issued to you or where you have agreed to be responsible.

Payments made on lost items are non refundable.

## Renewals

You are encouraged to renew items online, phone, or in person at the Mount Barker Community Library. In the instance that a borrower has reserved the item, a renewal is not possible.

The returns chute is located outside the main entrance at the Mount Barker Library.
