Membership

The library service is free and everyone is welcome to join.

Proof of identification is required (i.e. current address and signature). Young people under 18 years must have an application signed by a parent or adult caregiver.

As a member of the One Card Network, you can use your Murray Bridge Library card at any library in South Australia to borrow and return items.

You will need to bring your library card each visit if you wish to borrow or use computers in the library.

Please let us know as soon as possible if you change your address (with supporting documents) or if you lose your library card.

Library Loans

Library members can borrow up to 30 items at any one time from Murray Bridge Library on an Adult card and 20 items on a Child's card.

You can borrow the following:

. Books	4 week loan
. Magazines	2 week loan
. DVDs (5 items)	2 week loan
. CDs (5 items)	2 week loan
. Wii & DS games (1 item)	2 week loan
. Jigsaws (4 items)	4 week loan
. Audio books (5 items)	4 week loan
. Toys (Adult Cards) (4 items)	4 week loan
. Energy Kit	4 week loan

Library Catalogue

The on-line Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) allows you to search for resources held at any library in SA. Using your card and pin number you can view your personal borrowing record, as well as renew and reserve books, DVDs, CDs and magazines. Reservations and Renewals

You can reserve up to a total of 30 books, magazines, DVDs and CDs at a time. You will be notified by mail, email or SMS when the item is available.

Items may be renewed twice if the item is not reserved. This can be done in person or by phone during opening hours.

Items can be renewed online if they are not overdue. There are no reservations on toys.

Overdue charges

Please be aware that long overdue items will incur a charge.

When you have a debt of more than \$30 you cannot renew, borrow or reserve items from any One Card library (including Murray Bridge) until the debt has been paid at the library that sent the fine.

A separate \$5 processing fee is also charged when a library service initiates an account for an overdue item.

Returning items

A return chute is located at the circulation desk adjacent to the entrance.

For after-hours returns a chute is located in the exterior wall near the front doors.

Please return all toys to the Murray Bridge Library. You can also return items (other than toys) at any other library in SA.
